

Important Information Regarding Lab Work

As the patient, please understand that it is your responsibility to call your insurance company prior to having a blood draw to confirm if you have coverage or not, for any lab work that is being ordered by your provider. If you choose to have a blood draw without confirming with your insurance company first, you will be responsible to the lab for any portion that is not covered by your health insurance. _____ initial

Genetic testing is an example of lab work that may not be a covered benefit by your health insurance as well as some vitamins and minerals.
